New meetings held in recovery center where meeting room and coffee room are under video surveillance. One is an open discussion, the other an open step discussion. The concern is whether or not the Traditions for anonymity are being upheld and, if not, how can we work on preserving the traditions.

1. Group conscience elected that this be an open meeting, where all are welcome. To that effect, the verbiage was changed in the "what is the Narcotics Anonymous literature", read at the beginning of the meeting, to state "we are under video surveillance". However, this does not alert members to the surveillance until after the meeting has started, when they are already in the camera view. This will be addressed by placing placards at the door which disclose the presence of video cameras. Should this be adequate to protect the tradition of anonymity?
2. When listing the meeting in the where and when, should it be listed as an H+I meeting with video surveillance? This would give members the opportunity to make an informed decision about attendance.
